23. They report classes for crippled and shut-in students are settling down to a regular routine and proving most gratifying to those who are availing themselves of the privileges. Although registration is not up to capacity in either class, it is hoped that when the classes become better known the registration will increase.
24. They report that matters in connection with the Africville School are being dealt with and it is hoped that things will work out in a satisfactory manner.
25. They report thanks of the Supervisor for privilege extended him of attending the Convention of Canadian Education Association.
26. They recommend that leave of absence be granted Miss Gladys Gesner, Sir Charles Tupper School until February 1st, 1953, to attend classes at Columbia University to complete her necessary study to qualify for her M. A. Degree.
27. They recommend that permission be granted the Administrator to add a Class in Arc or Electric Welding to the classes already approved of by the Board, it being understood that there would be no additional cost to the Board.
28. They submit report of the Director of Physical Education and recommend that same be fyled for reference.
