<b>Subject: Winter Maintenance to Walking Paths in Regional Parks</b>		
<b>Motion for Transportation Standing Committee to Consider:</b>		
<p>That the Transportation Standing Committee request a staff report that investigates the advantages, disadvantages, and costs of providing winter maintenance to walking paths in regional parks such as Sir Sandford Fleming Park that do not currently receive winter maintenance.</p>		
<b>Reason:</b>		
<p>In keeping with Halifax's strategic plan and economic growth plan, current and prospective residents expect to be able live and recreate all year long. Our parks already help us accomplish our goals of creating healthy and vibrant communities for three seasons but many parts of our parks are inaccessible during the winter. Parks like Point Pleasant, Shubie, and the Public Gardens receive some winter maintenance while others do not.</p>		
<b>Outcome Sought:</b>		
<p>A staff report that provides a basis for Regional Council to determine if winter maintenance in more of our regional parks is warranted.</p>
