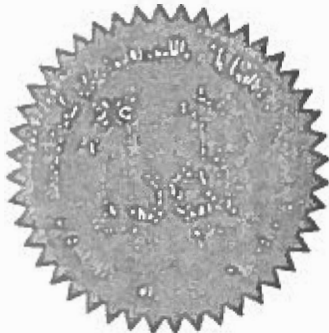
Parkinson's Awareness Month is April 2020 and brings into focus it's lifechanging effects.
