<p>Motion for Council to Consider:</p> <p>That Halifax Regional Council request a staff report regarding submitting an Infrastructure Funding Application to the Province of Nova Scotia for Active Transportation enhancements to the Mineville Road.</p> <p>Reason:</p> <p>The funding request will complete paved shoulders to create bike lanes along the primary residential zone of Mineville Road, 4.5 Kms from Highway 7 to the Candy Mountain Road intersection. This section of the Mineville Road has the highest intensity of walkers and cyclists in the community. This would safely connect the citizens to its local parks, playgrounds, sports-court, community mailbox gazebo, health clinic, church, carpool parking lot and convenience store. We are awaiting final cost estimates with cost sharing options to be considered.</p> <p>Outcome Sought:</p> <p>Council approval - this request is time sensitive matter whereby the Province is preparing to award a tender for the repaving of the Mineville Road.</p>
