## **HRP Police Science Program**

#### Program Overview

- Certificate in Police Science
- NS Private Career College\* program
- 38 weeks: 28 weeks classroom theory and practical skills development; 10 weeks of on-the-job field experience training
- \$10,000 all-inclusive tuition
- Halifax Regional Police Training School, located at 2 Chapman Dr., Dartmouth.
- Off-campus living
- Diverse instructor team comprised of active police officers and experts in their fields
- Core team comprised of Sgt, Cst, and Training and Curriculum Consultant
- \* Designated NS Private Career College, as per the NS Department of Labour and Advanced Education and approved by the NS Department of Justice.

#### Curriculum - Modules

Focus: 0-5 Years Patrol Officer

- 9. Motor Vehicle Act, Impaired Driving / SFST and Accident Investigations
- 10. Police Communications
- 11. Field Experience / On the Job Training (OJT)





All 23 cadets successfully graduated with a Certificate in Police Science and were sworn in to Halifax Regional Police as Patrol Constables on October 11, 2019.
