The Committee on School Sites & Buildings reports having advertised for tenders for repair work on Bloomfield High, Chebucto, Joseph Howe, Oxford, St. Patrick's Girls' High Schools on a cost plus percentage basis, and recommends that the contracts be awarded as follows:-

S. W. Brookfield, Ltd.	Bloomfield High and Joseph Howe
W. J. Harris & Son, Ltd.	Chebucto, Oxford and St. Patrick's Girls' High

- each at 10% labor 10% stock over cost.
2. - That application be made to the Governor in Council for an order on the City to issue its debentures to the amount required for portable schools.
 3. - They submit letter from Mr. John Morris, Caretaker asking for leave of absence on account of ill health and recommend that he be granted two months' leave
