Committee on Teachers

The verbal report of this Committee stated that in response to advertisement for Stationery Supplies for the year 1918-1919, letters had been received from Messrs J. C. Allen & Co. and W. Mackinlay Ltd. stating that under present conditions they were unable to quote prices for a year's supply to be delivered month by month. They could however supply a large quantity at once and then give quotations on subsequent supplies.

The Committee recommends that new specifications be submitted these firms along these lines giving a year's supply to each school instead of a month's supply.

Oxford School

The Chairman explained the difficulty experienced in trying to regain possession of Oxford School from the Health Board who wish to retain it as an infectious diseases hospital.

The Board requested the Chairman to take the matter up with the Board of Control.

Morris St. School

It was reported that on August 1 the Hospital will remove from Morris St. School.

The Chairmen of the Board and Comr. on Ed. B. with Mr. Hull were requested to inspect the fixtures and select any which it was desirable to retain.
