5. - They submit letters from the City Health Board and Engineer regarding their difficulties with the new isolation hospital and report that upon advice received they have notified the Health Board to vacate Oxford School by 5 o'clock on Thursday, Sept 5.
6. - They submit a letter from the Rhodes Curry Co. Ltd. asking for balance due on contract for erection of Richmond School extension.
7. - They have given careful consideration to the request of the School janitors for an increase in their pay and recommend that it be granted according to certain stipulations.

The Janitor of Afriville School to receive an increase of 4<sup>00</sup> a month, (his present salary is 8<sup>00</sup>)

That the janitor of Postable Schools be granted an increase of 5<sup>00</sup> per month for each school. (present pay 10<sup>00</sup> ea.)

That all other janitors be granted an increase of 15<sup>00</sup> per month commencing July 1.

That a bonus of 15<sup>00</sup> be granted janitors in whose building two schools hold session during such time, only, as the two schools are in session in the building.

8. - That the Board authorize this Committee to ask for competitive plans for the erection of Blomfield & Hepth's schools.
