<b>Subject: Restoration and Preservation of Fleming Cottage</b>		
<b>Motion for Regional Council to Consider:</b>  That Halifax Regional Council request a staff report on developing a plan to restore and preserve Sir Sandford Fleming Cottage, a registered heritage property owned by the municipality and situated in Sir Sandford Fleming Park.		
<b>Reason:</b>  Fleming Cottage has been sitting empty and boarded up for too many years now. The longer it sits, the further into disrepair it will fall.  As a registered heritage property owned by the municipality, Halifax has a responsibility to maintain it and to celebrate its historical significance.  Sir Sandford Fleming is a figure of local, national, and international significance.
