QUIT CLAIM DEED

THIS INDENTURE made this 15# day of Hugust A.D.1968;
BETWEEN:

RALPH JONES, GEORGE MANTLEY and LEON STEEDE Trustees of Seaview United Baptist Church, of Africville in the City of Halifax,

hereinafter called the "Grantors"
Of the One Part;

CITY OF HALIFAX, a body corporate, hereinafter called the "Grantee" Of the Other Part;

WHEREAS legislation was obtained at the 1964 session of the Nova Scotia Legislature to facilitate the acquisition by the City of Halifax of the property known as Africville in the City of Halifax, for redevelopment purposes;

AND WHEREAS the City of Halifax is now desirous of obtaining title to all the lands comprising the part of the City known as Africville;

AND WHEREAS the Grantors have an interest in some portion of Africville;

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH that the Grantors for and in consideration of the sum of \$15,000.00 -----of lawful money of Canada to the Grantors in hand well and truly paid by the Grantee at or before the sealing and delivery of

THESE PRESENTS (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have and each of them has remised, released, and forever quitted claim to, and by These Presents do and each of them does remise, release and forever quit claim, unto the Grantee, its Successors and Assigns,

ALL that certain lot, piece or parcel of land, situate in the City of Halifax and Province of Nova Scotia, and known as Africville, and more particularly shown bordered in red on City Plan No. TT-1-15899, dated February 1, 1964, and on file in the Office of the Commissioner of Works for the City of Halifax.
