Subject: Naming of Christian Isle		
Motion for Council to Consider:		
That Regional Council support the naming of an unnamed island to 'Christian Isle'.		
Reason:		
Christian is the family name. The family have traced back to the 1700 when the area was first settled. John Charles who was the official owner, formally granted the lands in 1837. The Duggan family arrived in this community in the 1700's also related to the later land owner, Al Duggan who purchased the land in 1935. The Christian and Duggan family have always lived in the community.
