REQUEST FOR FLY PAST - CUTLASS FURY 2021 REVISED

Sir,

CUTLASS FURY 21 is a biannual multinational joint-combined maritime tactical exercise that includes naval and air assets from Canada and three other NATO countries. It will occur from 07—17 September 2021, with the ships departing Halifax Harbour on 07 September. Nine Canadian warships and five visiting warships will slip and set sail into the Bedford Basin and then depart Halifax Harbour in a linear formation.

Royal Canadian Air Force (RCAF) aircrafts, including CH-148 Cyclones and a CP-140 Aurora, as well as Alpha Jets will pass over the ships as they depart in the vicinity of HMCS Sackville. It is requested that the Halifax Regional Municipality grants permission for the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) to fly RCAF assets over the Halifax Harbour as per the enclosed diagram. The air assets will fly at an altitude of 500 feet for the Fly Past at 1300 on 07 September 2021.


