

Mayor Savage,

This year's parades and remembrance of military personnel who served with valour and distinction and gave the ultimate sacrifice in the First World War, the Second World War, the Korean War, in United Nations Peacekeeping missions and most recently in Afghanistan, will occur on Thursday, 11 November 2021. Due to COVID-19, this year's ceremonies will be substantially scaled back and 12 Wing participation has been restricted to Cenotaph Vigils, Wreath Laying Parties and Pipers for the Somme Branch Legion in Dartmouth, the Centennial Branch Legion in Cole Harbour, and the Caen Branch Legion in Eastern Passage. There will be no "Marching Contingents" as in years past, however these events will include a flypast from a Cyclone helicopter from 12 Wing Shearwater.

It is requested that the Halifax Regional Municipality grant permission for the Canadian Forces to fly a Cyclone helicopter over Sullivan's Pond in Dartmouth at approximately 1108 hours flying North to South, over Cole Harbour Place at approximately 1109 hours flying East to West, and at the Caen Legion Branch #164 on Main Road Eastern Passage at approximately 1110 hours flying North to South. Requesting flypasts be authorized to fly at a height of 500 feet above the highest obstacle in each location.

The continued support of the Halifax Regional Municipality to this annual remembrance of our shared history is very much appreciated.
