Subject: Review of Noise By-law N-200		
Motion for Council to Consider: That Halifax Regional Council request a staff report on conducting a review of the Noise By-law N-200 to determine a measurable decibel level that is acceptable within a community.		
Reason: Requesting that a review of Noise By-law N-200 be conducted to assess how staff currently determines that an activity unreasonably disturbs the peace and tranquility of a neighbourhood, whether a measurable and objective means of determining noise level is more appropriate, what the noise level should be set at, and what options are available for measurement and enforcement.		
Outcome Sought: A staff report outlining a measurable decibel level that is acceptable within a neighbourhood.
