

## Proclamation National Housing Day November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2021

WHEREAS, Safe, sustainable and equitable housing is a basic human need and a requirement for good mental health. When housing is inadequate or unavailable, personal as well as community well-being can suffer.

National Housing Day is an opportunity to recognize the important work being done throughout the community to improve access to safe, affordable, and sustainable housing for everyone and to reflect on the work that still needs to be done.

Most importantly, National Housing Day serves as a call to action for all Nova Scotians to support efforts to promote the need for safe, sustainable, and affordable housing, and the need to reduce barriers to obtaining equitable housing.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT I, Mayor Mike Savage on behalf of Regional Council Proclaim November 22, 2021, as National Housing Day; as a reminder to all Nova Scotians that access to safe, sustainable and equitable housing affects our collective mental health; and to have a mentally healthy community we must work together to ensure every member of our community has a place to call home.
