### PUBLIC HEARING FOR KEARNEY LAKE

#### DEVELOPMENT: DEC 14

There will be a public hearing on December 14th involving 33 acres of land on the east side of Kearney Lake Road stretching from Gem Lane to Highway 102 (Exit 2), including the former quarry site. The land owners are applying to develop their lands with residential, commercial and institutional uses. Details of future buildings are still to be determined and will be decided through later hearings however the buildings may range from 4 storeys near Kearney Lake Road to 12 storeys further back. Future development must comply with existing policies and engineering requirements to protect lake water quality.

### PROVINCIAL CLIMATE PLAN ON THE WAY

Nova Scotia's Minister of Environment and Climate Change Tim Halman met with councillors at City Hall on December 2 (at the invitation of HRM council's Environment and Sustainability Committee). Minister Halman told us he's working on a climate plan that will be introduced next spring with the "boldest and most ambitious goals in Canada". The plan will include a pathway to 80% renewable energy, 30% electric vehicles and 20% of land conserved, all by 2030.

Minister Halman praised HRM's climate plan HalifACT, and said he would take a collaborative and "all hands on deck approach".
