LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

Downtown Halifax Land Use By-law, section 4(13)(d) provides:

4 (13) The Committee shall:

...

(d) advise Council on potential amendments to regulation and policy to carry out the role and responsibilities of the Committee or to further the intent of this by-law as may be required from time to time.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Halifax Regional Council:

1. Give First Reading to consider an amendment to the Land Use By-law for Downtown Halifax as contained in Attachment A of the October 28, 2021 report and schedule a public hearing; and
2. Adopt the amendment to the Land Use By-law for Downtown Halifax, as set out in Attachment A of the October 28, 2021 report.
