## Parking Policy

#### **Regional Parking Strategy (2008)**

"Current parking bylaws outside of the Halifax Peninsula generally require more parking than is needed."

#### **Integrated Mobility Plan (2017)**

Amend municipal planning strategies and land use by-laws to reduce parking requirements

#### Timberlea, Lakeside, Beechville Planning Strategy

The By-law shall require parking of an <u>adequate</u> size to provide for the needs of users of the facility and to address potential off-site impacts



### **Proposed Amendments**

Reduce the minimum parking requirements for community centres and recreation facilities in the Beecvhille / Lakeside / Timberlea plan area.

	Parking Standard	Spaces Required
	Minimum	(30,000 ft <sup>2</sup> rec centre)
Existing	1 space / 100 ft <sup>2</sup>	307
Proposed	1 space / 500 ft <sup>2</sup>	62

### Staff Recommendation

Staff recommend that Halifax and West Community Council:

Adopt the proposed amendments to the Land Use By-law for Timberlea/ Lakeside/ Beechville to reduce the parking requirements for recreation facilities and community centres.
