<b>Date of Council Meeting: May 17, 2022</b>		
<b>Subject: Renewal of funding for TNR program for control of feral cats</b>		
<b>Motion for Council to Consider:</b>  That Halifax Regional Council direct the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) to provide a staff report and recommendations with respect to continued funding for the SPCA's Trap, Neuter, Release program for feral cats for another five years.		
<b>Reason:</b>  The SPCA's Trap Neuter Release program has successfully controlled the feral cat population in HRM through surgery and humane care. Without continued funding to maintain this program, feral cat populations will quickly soar and will require additional funding to bring populations back under control. Regional Council may once again be spending valuable meeting time discussing this issue when a solution has already been found.		
<b>Outcome Sought:</b>  To provide \$25,000/year in funding to the SPCA to continue the TNR program and surgery for feral cats.
