Subject: Lakeview Point Road/Hume Street Extension		
Motion for Council to Consider: That Halifax Regional Council rescind item 15.3.1 "Lakeview Point Road/Hume Street Extension" from the October 26, 2021 meeting which requested a staff report as follows: "That Halifax Regional Council request a staff report regarding the feasibility of converting Lakeview Point Road and Hume Street in Dartmouth into a one-way loop by creating a new exit for Hume Street at the existing traffic light at Grahams Grove."		
Reason: Work on the intersection of Lakeview Point Road and Prince Albert Road has been completed and residents have indicated that HRM's design is working well. A majority of people from the neighbourhood have expressed that there isn't any real need to look at alternative access out of Lakeview Point Road at this time.
