NOTICE OF SECOND READING BY-LAW R-109, RESPECTING THE REPEAL OF BY-LAWS AND ORDINANCES

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Halifax Regional Municipality will consider the adoption of By-law R-109 at a meeting of Regional Council to be held on **Tuesday**, **July 12**, **2022** in the Halifax Council Chamber, 1841 Argyle Street, Halifax.

By-law R-109 will amend By-law R-100 Respecting the Repeal of By-law and Ordinances. The purpose of the amendment is to repeal By-law P-800, the Pesticide By-law, which will be replaced with an Integrated Pest Management Strategy. If the By-law is repealed, pesticide regulation will fall under the existing Non-essential Pesticides Control Act of 2010, which is administered by the Nova Scotia Department of Environment and Climate Change under the Environment Act. As such, repealing By-law P-800 is a matter of administrative housekeeping to align HRM policy with that of the Province, and will not impact the availability and use of non-essential pesticides.

The Council will receive written submissions from interested persons concerning the above bylaw at the July 12, 2022 session of Council. Written submissions must be received by the Municipal Clerk's Office no later than 9:00 a.m. on the advertised date.
