Subject: Gravel Road Paving Program for HRM Owned Roads		
Motion for Council to Consider: That Halifax Regional Council direct the Chief Administrative Officer to provide a staff report evaluating a potential Gravel Road Paving Program for HRM-owned roads that considers an annual funding allocation and the following prioritization criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Cost-benefit of paving- Existing road condition and level of maintenance- Road classification- Traffic volume- Storm water management- Winter maintenance- Surrounding public amenities such as parks, schools, lake access, etc. And further, direct the Chief Administrative Officer to undertake pre-engineering work on HRM gravel roads, in accordance with Regional Council's current approved prioritization criteria, to ensure that Regional Council can consider paving up to \$500K of HRM gravel roads as part of the 2023/24 budget process.
