<b>Date of Council Meeting:</b> August 23, 2022		
<b>Subject:</b> Cooling centres in designated locations in HRM		
<b>Motion for Council to Consider:</b>  That Halifax Regional Council direct the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) to provide a staff report on the cost and effectiveness of providing cooling centres in designated locations in HRM. These cooling centres would provide some cooling comfort due to rising heat temperatures experienced, which are being influenced by global climate change.		
<b>Reason:</b> Based on communication from vulnerable persons in HRM, this is a great opportunity for Council to look at the cost of cooling centres. Heat warning were announced more than once in most of HRM this summer. Cooling centres would operate, in the same way as our warming centres by assisting our most vulnerable residents.
