

Youth Award Nomination Form

Each year the Mayor and Halifax Regional Council recognize the extraordinary contributions of outstanding individuals and groups who volunteer their time and skills to provide services and programs in our communities.

Thank you for taking the time to nominate an outstanding youth. Please read the following criteria carefully before filling out your nomination

NOMINATION CRITERIA

Youth volunteers must be between the ages of 13 and 19.

Youth Volunteers who meet the following criteria, are eligible for a Volunteer Award:

- Demonstrates initiative, leadership and creativity in service to others;
- Serves as a role model for others;
- Inspires others to engage in volunteer service;
- Improves the overall quality of life of fellow citizens and the community.
- Ensure the volunteer's efforts are voluntary and not paid;
- Paid work cannot be listed on the form;
- Volunteer must be a resident of Halifax Regional Municipality;
- Nominators may only nominate one youth per nomination form;
- The youth volunteer cannot have received this award in the last 5 years.
- For your nominee to be considered for the Provincial Volunteer Awards, please complete all sections of the form.
- This is a scored process. The top 97 (adult and/or youth) volunteers will receive an award. The top 10 volunteers will be put forward to receive a provincial award. The top scoring nominee will be the Municipality's Volunteer of the Year.

Nominations that are unclear, inaccurate, late or do not comply with the criteria may not be accepted or could negatively impact your volunteer's score.

AWARD SELECTION PROCESS

- All nominations are scored.
- Awards are allotted in each of the Municipality's 16 electoral districts.
- All nominees and award recipients are presented to the Executive Standing Committee of Council and to Regional Council for final approval.
- Successful nominees will be invited to attend a ceremony and reception in April with the Mayor and Regional Council to receive their award
- Nominators will receive a letter in March informing them of the status of their nominee.
- The top ten scoring nominees from either the youth or adult categories will be selected to represent the Municipality at the Provincial Volunteer Awards, where they will receive a second award.
