Good afternoon,

Sorry, I wasn't aware that the deadline was a week before. In particular as regards the issue of use of force, this is a matter of national significance given the news coverage of the Toronto data on use of force and Black communities. For the past weeks, I have been working with people in Uniacke Square who are traumatized by recent use of force incidents in delivering warrants. My purpose in presenting to the Board is to raise the following issues:

1) The need for data similar to that gathered in Toronto to track use of force incidents by race in Halifax.

2) The lack of access to policies particularly around the detention of minors, women, people with trauma and people with medical issues.

3) The worrisome escalation in the uses of "SWAT" or ERT to deliver warrants, including the use of an armoured vehicle.

4) The community impacts of this policing and its traumatic effects.

5) The recommendations in the Defunding Report that address these trends.

My delay in submitting a request to present was due to the need to make sure those impacted had accessed counselling and legal advice before speaking. However, I feel that this issue is important and within the Board's sphere of governance.
