Independence Day of Latvia
November 18, 2022

WHEREAS, November 18, 1918 is the date of the Republic of Latvia Independence Day; and

WHEREAS, The Republic of Latvia, member of the European Union and NATO, has been an important player on the global stage for peace and security, human rights, social and economic human development, green economy; and
