Successes - 2022 Accessibility Projects

- Fort Needham Park Washroom building completed
- o Accessible Beach mats add at Campbell Point Beach.
- Kiwanis Grahams Grove Park facility under construction
- Halifax Commons Pool facility under construction
- Woodside Ferry Terminal renovations have been completed with many accessible upgrades.
- o Canada Game Centre Universal Changeroom Upgrades completed
- Dartmouth North Community Centre Renovations to completed by December, including new universal washrooms.
- Modernized elevator at the Alderney Landing underway
- Continuation of the automatic door operator program
- 2 additional team members completed the Rick Hansen Foundation Certification Program.
- Adult Change tables included as appropriate in public facilities.
- Working with the Government of NS, member of the Technical Committee on Accessibility to develop standards to audit current conditions.

Challenges

- Renovating existing buildings to meet CSA standards due to physical limitation of the building.
