United Food and Commercial Workers Union (UFCW) Day
December 12th, 2022

WHEREAS the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society of Canada (LLSC) is the largest registered charitable health agency dedicated to supporting the blood cancer community in Canada and their mission is to cure all 137 types of blood cancer and to improve the quality of life of people affected by blood cancers and their families by funding life-enhancing research and providing educational resources, services and support; and

WHEREAS the United Food and Commercial Workers Union (UFCW) members and local unions across Canada adopted the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society of Canada as their charity of choice nearly 40 years ago and since then have raised over \$49 million; and

WHEREAS under the leadership of Tim Hosford, National Representative at UFCW Canada, UFCW Eastern Provinces Council has been supporting LLSC since 2011 and have raised over \$338,000 to benefit the blood cancer here in Atlantic Canada; and

WHEREAS LLSC is extraordinarily proud of the UFCW and recognizes their dedication and passion for supporting the LLSC mission.
