Here is the further information. I can advise that a representative of The Halifax Military Heritage Preservation Society (HMHPS) would like an opportunity (10-15min.) to address the Halifax West Community Council on the 17th.

Point Pleasant Park at the southern end of the Halifax Peninsula holds a unique place in the history of K'jipuktuk/Chebucto/Halifax and Nova Scotia. The site was a significant gathering place for the Mi'kmaq prior to the British establishing Halifax in 1749. For the next two centuries-- as part of the wider Halifax Defence Complex –Point Pleasant Park served as an important defensive site where a number of fortifications and batteries were constructed to guard the harbour entrance and naval installations.

During WW II the internationally-recognized port of Halifax was one of the Allies principal staging areas for merchant convoys supplying critical food, fuel and other war materiel to Great Britain. Point Pleasant Park defences and the other Halifax Defence Complex sites played a pivotal role in helping ensure victory at sea during the pivotal Battle of the Atlantic.

Finally, a representative during the presentation will be making a request for consideration as decisions move forward. I look forward to having a society representative present on this critical matter. A full outline letter will be given to the committee during the presentation. The society would like to see better preservation of Point Pleasant Park Battery and the other fortifications within the park. The preservation would be a great tourism opportunity.
