Subject: Feely Lake		
Motion for Regional Council to Consider: That Halifax Regional Council direct the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) to provide a staff information report on the lands surrounding Feely Lake including the history of the land transfer, the original intention of the lands, why these plans were not realized and steps that need to be taken to complete this transfer.		
Reason: Residents requesting development of green space that was provided during land transfer. When the Province of Nova Scotia developed the community of Millwood in the early 1990's, as with all developments, lands around Feely Lake were set aside as parkland. At the end of the development, the lands were supposed to be transferred to the municipality. There is confusion about when this was supposed to be done. This report will give the history of the lands and reestablish the path forward to having them developed as parkland.		
Outcome Sought: Information on land transfer and what steps are required to develop the green space as intended.
