
Origin

- July 16, 2019, Halifax Regional Council motion (Item No.15.7.2):


MOVED by Councillor Walker, seconded by Councillor Cleary

Current Community Boundary




Consultation Policy


Administrative Order 29 – Respecting Civic Addressing

Communities at risk of being affected by major change in GSA (General Service Area, aka Community) boundaries shall be informed, and consulted before, during and after the process.



Public Engagement Feedback

- Level of engagement completed was consultation achieved through meetings and virtual consultation with community groups, local Councillors, and written communication with affected property owners and residents.
- Feedback from the community generally included clarifying the following:
 - if the property owner's land was affected by the proposal
 - if the zoning or taxes would be affected
 - if other boundaries would be affected (i.e. school)

Staff Recommendation

The staff recommendation contained in the staff report was arrived at after public engagement.

It is recommended that Halifax Regional Council:

- Approve the proposed community boundaries for the communities of Beechville, Lakeside, Halifax and Goodwood as set out in Map 1 in the staff report dated May 9, 2023 and;
- Authorize staff to install and relocate community signs as identified in Map 2 of the staff report dated May 9, 2023.
