I have discussed with Diane Levandier and Lillian Ash (HRM Recreation) the need to bring the Cycling Without Age program to Musquodoboit Harbour, for use on the HRM Active Transportation Spine; Musquodoboit Trailways and the Gaetz Brook Greenway.
