That the Chair of the Board of Police Commissioners write a letter to the Provincial Ministers of Justice and Health requesting that regulations be drafted pursuant to section 83(1)(i) of the <i>Involuntary Psychiatric Treatment Act</i>, SNS 2005, c 42 to define "other authorized individual" under section 16(2) of the <i>Act</i>, so as to permit someone other than a peace officer to remain at the place of a medical examination and retain custody of a person undergoing a medical examination until such examination is completed.2. That the Chair of the Board of Police Commissioners write a letter to the Acting CEO of Nova Scotia Health requesting that funds be designated to hire additional clinicians for the Mental Health Mobile Crisis Team (MHMCT).
