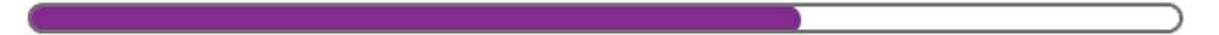

Premier apologizes for past treatment

The Disabled Rights Coalition of Nova Scotia and long-time disability rights advocate Vicky Levack are applauding an apology from the premier of the province for protracted and systemic government discrimination against people with disabilities.

"It was a very good apology it wasn't just 'sorry' but then they said what they were sorry for," said Levack, a 32-year-old with cerebral palsy who lived in Arborstone Enhanced Care in Halifax for a decade before moving last year into an apartment for the first time in her adult life as part of a provincial pilot program.

"Their actions, what they did in the past was wrong and I know a lot of people with disabilities have been waiting to hear that for decades," Levack said. "I, myself, have been waiting to hear it for a decade. It was really meaning-
