Dear Sherry

Thanks for the conversation yesterday. I am a member of the Save Centennial Pool Committee. The Committee was formed in July 2023 at the Annual General Meeting of the Centennial Pool Association (CPA). It includes some members of the CPA board and a broad range of volunteers from the larger Centennial Pool users and community. The Committee was initially formed in response to a motion to council,

from June 28/2022, Item No.15.4.2, Subject: Replacement of 50m pool in HRM.

This letter is written on behalf of the Committee to request the opportunity to present to the HRM Community Planning and Economic Development standing committee at the December 14(?) 2023 meeting. We are requesting a December meeting because the staff report requested in the motion (Item No.15.4.2) may come before council in the new year.

The motion calls for the potential disposal of Centennial pool for economic development along with the development of a new, replacement 50m pool and the prioritization of the replacement of the Needham Community Centre. **This report was requested shortly after COVID and an extended closure of the pool.** From our research and community engagement we understand that there are many factors that may not have been considered in advance of the HRM Council motion for the staff report recommending the disposal of Centennial pool.

We would welcome an opportunity to present our findings that better enable the process for completing a full analyses and making a fully informed decision.

Thank you for your consideration and for the work you do. I look forward to hearing from you.
