

Acting Today for Tomorrow

We're reducing Halifax Stanfield's carbon footprint by:

- Constructing a new taxiway on one of our runways to improve aircraft operational efficiency, reducing aircraft engine idling.
- Installing electric vehicle and equipment charging infrastructure for airport operations and those who park at the airport.
- Replacing lighting fixtures on our airfield and in our buildings with energy-efficient LED technology.









Together is Better

We're working collaboratively with HRM by:

- Sharing input on proposed updates to the land-use by-laws around the airport.
- Finding solutions to improve the passenger experience for the Halifax Transit Airport Express
- Cleaning up illegal dumping sites on the Old Guysborough Rd. following discussions with our area Councillor.
