Subject: Expansion of Graphic Crosswalk Program to Include Indigenous Crosswalk Design		
Motion for Council to Consider:		
THAT Halifax Regional Council direct the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) to provide a staff report on potential design options for Indigenous Crosswalks and costs of including these designs as part of HRM's graphic crosswalk program.		
Reason: Mi'kmaq are Nova Scotia's first people. In recent discussions with Mi'kmaq leaders, there were expressions of interest to have crosswalks with Indigenous designs. Crosswalks can be designed to celebrate the culture and heritage of Indigenous community members living within the municipality. These crosswalks can also be used to recognize Mi'kmaq History month.		
Outcome Sought: Staff report that specifies potential design and costs of incorporating these designs into HRM's graphic crosswalk program.
