Hello,

I am emailing with a request for representatives from the Halifax Rugby Football Club to present at the January 19 Community Planning and Economic Development Standing Committee meeting.

I and Maddison Dennison (copied here) are members of the Clubhouse Committee. Our aim is to work with the city to get a clubhouse built adjacent to the sports field at Gorsebrook Park (our home field) that includes public washrooms. We have been in conversations with a number of people, including councillor Mason, who is supportive of this project, and Maggie MacDonald ED of Parks and Recreation. Maggie recommended that a presentation to the standing committee would be the next appropriate step.

The outcome we are seeking is for council to direct staff to

- engage with us on our public consultation phase
- do a staff report on our project

If possible, we would like to get this approval sooner than later as it will allow us to apply for provincial funding for the current fiscal year for planning assistance.
