ABR training continues with several assorted business units.

The ABR Grants program is designed to support grassroots initiatives and projects that combat anti-Black racism. This program aims to provide funding to community organizations and individuals dedicated to creating positive change and addressing systemic inequalities. Grant opportunities will be available to all eligible organizations that support projects that address the ABR grant program funding priorities." Please note priority will be given to applicants from the African Nova Scotia and African descent communities, with an emphasis on grassroots, volunteer-led groups serving local residents By empowering local efforts, we aim to foster a more inclusive and equitable community.

ANSAIO is organizing upcoming community circles focused on wildfire management as well as municipal elections.

The municipal election sessions will provide valuable information on how to vote, work at polling stations, and run for office. Additionally, we will be starting up employment circles again this fall to support community members in finding job opportunities within the municipality. ANSAIO will provide the dates to the committee through the clerk's office once solidified.
