<p>Date of Meeting: June 17, 2024</p> <p>Subject: Police Transformation Study & MCC Report Recommendations</p>		
<p>That the Board of Police Commissioners:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Direct the Chief of the HRP and advise the Officer in Charge of the RCMP to work together in reviewing each recommendation contained in the MCC Report, Volume 5, Policing; 2) Direct the Chief of the HRP and advise the Officer in Charge of the RCMP to produce a joint staff report outlining those recommendations in which they are able to work together to implement; and 3) Direct the Chief of the HRP and advise the Officer in Charge of the RCMP to provide joint quarterly updates using the Joint Chief Reporting Template 		
<p>Reason:</p> <p>This motion builds on the Police Transformation Study's recommendation to implement "a fully integrated model of police service delivery by coordinating, integrating and standardizing policing services in HRM under common policies and standard operating procedures." MCC recommendations that are directed at the RCMP present an opportunity for these recommendations to also be explored by the HRP to ensure a consistent level of service delivery across both police agencies.</p>
