2.9.3. Fire Hazards and Control2.9.3.1. Electrical Systems
 The electrical system in a tent or air-supported structure shall be maintained and operated in a safe manner. Portable electrical systems shall be inspected for fire hazards and defects shall be corrected before the tent or air-supported structure is occupied by the public. The electrical system and equipment in a tent or air-supported structure, including electrical fuses and switches, shall be inaccessible to the public. Cables on the ground in areas used by the public in a tent or air-supported structure shall be placed in trenches or protected by covers to prevent damage from traffic.
