Subject: Musquodoboit Valley/Dutch Settlement Land Use By-law		
Motion for North West Community Council to Consider: That North West Community Council direct the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) to provide a staff recommendation report regarding amendments to the Musquodoboit Valley/Dutch Settlement Land Use By-law to consider a reduction in the minimum parking requirements for a 'day care facilities' use and any additional requirements which might be necessary to reduce possible impacts to the road network.		
Reason: The current Musquodoboit Valley/Dutch Settlement Land Use By-law requires 32 parking spaces, which is not feasible for the area, nor is it a requirement of the daycare where parents will be doing drop off and pick up. Therefore, a reduction in the number of parking spots is required.
