EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The 2024 Road Safety Annual Report provides an overview of the current state of road safety in the Halifax Regional Municipality. The Municipality has adopted a Vision Zero concept, as well as an intermediate goal to maintain a downward trend in the rate of fatal and serious injury collisions per 100,000 residents. Key performance indicators monitoring various aspects of road safety, as well as the ongoing and planned actions of the road safety program are presented herein.

This report has been prepared for the Transportation Standing Committee as an information item, and there are no specific recommendations associated with this report. There are no immediate financial implications associated with this report.

BACKGROUND

The <u>Road Safety Strategy</u>, approved by Regional Council in July 2024, is Halifax Regional Municipality's second guiding document for the Road Safety Program, which adopts the principles of Vision Zero and the Safe System Approach to road safety. The Road Safety Strategy (the Strategy) is based on a vision of zero fatalities and serious injuries for all road users in the Halifax Regional Municipality by 2038, and an intermediate goal to maintain a downward trend in the rate of fatal and serious injury collisions per 100,000 residents. Annual reporting is a key deliverable in the implementation of the Strategy.

This report is the first prepared following the approval of the Strategy. An overview of collision statistics and key performance indicators are included for the 2023 calendar year, as well as highlights from ongoing and planned actions within the Road Safety Program. **Attachment 1 – 2024 Road Safety Annual Report** provides further details of collision statistics and program activities.

DISCUSSION

Collision Overview

The goal of the road safety program, established in the Strategy, is to maintain a continuous downward trend in the rate of fatal and serious injury collisions per 100,000 residents. In preparation for this report, serious injury data was added to the HRM collision database; however, on evaluation of the newly available data staff identified concerns with the accuracy of the data related to injury severity. Given the concerns with data quality, Halifax Regional Police (HRP) and Halifax Regional Detachment (HRD) have advised staff to proceed without this component of the injury data for this year's report. Moving forward, HRP and HRD have agreed to work with staff to determine the cause and scope of the data quality issues related to injury severity, and to review their QA/QC processes to improve the quality of new and existing data. The resolution of this issue must be a priority for the 2024/25 year, in order for the Road Safety Program to align evaluation and reporting with the Vision Zero commitment and goals of the Strategy.




Figure 1: Rate of fatal and injury collisions per 100,000 residents, 2018-2023 (Municipal and Provincial Right of Way). Data for this figure is taken from closed collision files from Halifax Regional Police and RCMP Halifax Regional Detachment. Future reports may vary slightly as further files are closed or existing files amended.

In absence of serious injury data, all injury data is presented below as a temporary replacement to evaluate annual progress. In 2023 there were 6 fatal collisions and 785 injury collisions on public roadways in the Halifax Regional Municipality, including municipally and provincially owned roads and highways. **Figure 1** shows the annual rate of fatal and injury collisions per 100,000 population, with the 3-year rolling average from 2020 onward.




Figure 2: Pedestrian and Micromobility Collisions, 2019-2023. Right-of-way collisions on Municipal and Provincial roads, all severities.

The safety of vulnerable road users is a priority area identified in the Strategy, and staff perform an annual review of all reported collisions involving pedestrians and micromobility users (people riding bicycles and scooters, including e-bikes and e-scooters) to identify trends and potentially dangerous locations. For 2023, staff reviewed 168 pedestrian collisions and 64 micromobility collisions. The total number of all pedestrian and micromobility collisions over the last five years are shown in **Figure 2**. Key points from this review are found in **Attachment 1 – 2024 Road Safety Annual Report**.

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Road Safety Key Performance Indicators

Established in the Road Safety Strategy are ten key performance indicators, which will be reported on an annual basis to monitor various aspects of the Road Safety Program and the state of road safety in the Municipality. **Table 1** presents the 2023 values for these indicators. Additional values for each of these indicators - dating back to 2018 where available - and supplementary information are found in **Attachment 4 – Road Safety Key Performance Indicators**. As the Strategy was recently approved, some indicators are not yet available for 2023. Indicators shown in italics require police data QA/QC improvements, the establishment of new data collection, analysis, and/or processes which are currently in development, and will be reported in future reports.

Road Safety Projects

The Road Safety Program is responsible for leading and participating in an array of projects and initiatives, spanning five priority areas: Intersections; Safe Speeds; Vulnerable Road Users; Safe Schools; and Data Management. Actions completed in 2023 along with ongoing and planned actions for 2024 are outlined by priority area in **Table 2**. Further details of these projects are found in **Attachment 1 – 2024 Road Safety Annual Report**.

Most projects presented in Table 2, which are led or supported by road safety staff, are infrastructure changes which fall under the engineering approach described in the Road Safety Strategy. While infrastructure improvements are a critical component of road safety, education, engagement and enforcement are necessary additional approaches to complement infrastructure improvements and create a multi-disciplinary Safe System approach. Road safety staff rely on Halifax Regional Police, RCMP Halifax Regional Detachment, and Corporate Communications to lead these approaches. Details of the supporting work done by these partners are found in **Attachment 1 – 2024 Road Safety Annual Report**, and **Attachment 5 – 2023 Traffic Enforcement Statistics**.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no immediate financial implications associated with this report. Additional staff resources may be identified in future capital and operating budgets to achieve the goals and priorities of the Road Safety Strategy.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Community engagement was not conducted as part of this report.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

Section 21 of the Halifax Regional Municipal Charter states that:

- (1) The Council may establish standing, special and advisory committees.
- (2) Each committee shall perform the duties conferred on it by this Act, any other Act of the Legislature or the by-laws or policies of the Municipality.




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
1. Introduction

The Road Safety Strategy, approved by Regional Council in July 2024, is Halifax Regional Municipality's second guiding document for the Road Safety Program, which adopts the principles of Vision Zero and the Safe System Approach to road safety. The Road Safety Strategy (the Strategy) is based on a vision of zero fatalities and serious injuries for all road users in the Halifax Regional Municipality by 2038, and a goal to maintain a downward trend in the rate of fatal and serious injury collisions per 100,000 residents.

Annual reporting is a key deliverable identified in the Strategy. This report will provide an overview of current collision statistics in the municipality and initiates reporting of key performance indicators as established in the Strategy. Highlights of the 2023/24 Road Safety Program are outlined, as well as ongoing and future planned projects.

2. Collision data overview: What is happening

There were 6 fatal and 785 injury collisions reported on municipal and provincial roads within the Halifax Regional Municipality in 2023. These numbers may differ from previously reported, or future values, as collision reports are filed or reclassified. Figure 1 shows the rate of fatal and all injury collisions per 100,00 residents, in the period between 2018 and 2023, as well as the three-year rolling average of the rate.



The reporting of injury collisions in this report is based on collisions which are filed by Police as injury collisions, which can range from minor to serious injuries. Future Road Safety Annual Reports, as indicated in the Road Safety Strategy, are expected to report on injury severity, with a focus on serious injuries, to better align with the Vision Zero principle that there should be no fatalities or serious injuries on our roadways.

In preparation for this report, staff worked with Halifax Regional Police (HRP) and HRM Data Services to enable the transfer of further collision details into the HRM collision database, which would enable the reporting of injury severity, as well as the number of individual injuries and fatalities resulting from collisions. In evaluating the newly available data, staff identified concerns with the accuracy of the data related to injury severity. Given the concerns with data quality, HRP has advised staff to proceed without this component of the injury data for this year's report. Moving forward, HRP have agreed to work with staff to determine the cause and scope of the data quality issues related to injury severity, and to review their QA/QC processes to improve the quality of new and existing data.

Table 1 presents the number of total collisions, and number and rates of fatal and all injury collisions occurring within the HRM right-of-way, from 2018 to 2023.

The total number of fatal and injury collisions recorded for 2023 shows an increase in the overall number, with a modest decrease in the rate. While it is noted that the number of fatal collisions decreased by nearly half in 2023, in the absence of reliable injury severity data staff are unable to determine if the number of serious injury collisions has increased or decreased over this period.

It should be noted that the upward trend in the three-year rolling average in 2023 is partially affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, as low collision rates from the year 2020 are no longer included in the three-year timeframe. Despite this, the upward trend in the three-year rolling average in 2023 suggests that more action and support may be required to meet the goal of the Strategy in future years. The Road Safety group will continue to focus work through the approach and the principles of equity and evidence-based decision making, approved within the 2024 Road Safety Strategy. A coordinated, multi-disciplinary approach is a foundation for an effective Vision Zero commitment, and the Road Safety group will require continued and enhanced support and collaboration from other municipal and provincial business units to achieve success in the vision and goal of the Road Safety Strategy.



2.1 COLLISIONS INVOLVING PEDESTRIANS AND MICROMOBILITY USERS

The safety of vulnerable road users is identified as a priority area for the Road Safety program. To assess risk factors and identify trends specific to this priority area, staff evaluate all reported collisions involving pedestrians and micromobility users each year.




Figure 2: Pedestrian and micromobility collisions 2019-2023 (right-of-way collisions, all severities)

The 2023 collision data review identified 168 collisions involving pedestrians, and 64 collisions between motor vehicles and micromobility users, occurring on public roadways. These numbers may differ from previously reported, or future values, as collision reports are filed or reclassified. The total number of all pedestrian collisions and micromobility collisions in the last five years are shown in Figure 2.

Pedestrian collisions:

was able to confirm a different traffic control type for the vehicle involved.




Figure 3: 2023 Pedestrian collisions by traffic control type

• Figure 3 shows the breakdown of 2023 pedestrian collisions by traffic control type. Note, this chart shows collisions classified by the traffic control type associated with the vehicle involved in the collision and not the overall intersection. For example, where there is a marked crosswalk on the major street and stop control on the side street, the control type may be either marked crossing or stop control depending on the collision configuration. Staff review all collision reports to confirm information provided and traffic control type may, in some cases, differ from the type listed in the police report where further investigation

- Intersections, including signalized intersections, stop controlled intersections, roundabouts, and driveways, continue to be the site of the majority of pedestrian collisions. In 2023, 36 per cent, or 61 pedestrian collisions occurred at signalized intersections.
- At signalized intersections, roughly half of pedestrian collisions (52 per cent, or 32 collisions) involved left turning vehicles.
- Fall continues to be the time of year when higher pedestrian related collisions occur, with 23 occurring in December, and 16 in September.
- Five intersections experienced more than one pedestrian collision in 2023:
 - Barrington Street & South Street (3)
 - Dunbrack Street & Farnham Gate Road (2)
 - Dunbrack Street & Main Avenue (2)
 - Jubilee Road & Robie Street (2)
 - Morris Street & Queen Street (2)

Micromobility collisions:

- motor vehicles.
- intersections, with 23 per cent and 22 per cent of the collisions respectively.




Figure 4: 2023 Vehicle-micromobility collisions by facility type

• Micromobility devices include bicycles, e-bikes, electric scooters and other lightweight vehicles. In this report, vehicle-micromobility collisions refer to collisions between micromobility devices and registered

• The largest share, about 30 per cent, of vehicle-micromobility collisions occurred on roadway segments, between intersections. The next most common configurations were at driveways and signalized

• 73 per cent of vehicle-micromobility collisions occurred at locations where there was no dedicated micromobility facility. Figure 4 shows 2023 micromobility collisions by facility type. Facility type is

- In 17 per cent of vehicle-micromobility collisions, the user was travelling on the sidewalk or within a pedestrian crosswalk.
- **Figure 5** shows the breakdown of 2023 vehicle-micromobility collisions by configuration. Most collisions involved vehicles turning at intersections and driveways.




Figure 5: 2023 Vehicle-micromobility collisions by collision configuration



3. Road Safety Key Performance Indicators: How we're doing

The Road Safety Strategy establishes a list of 10 key performance indicators (KPIs) to measure and monitor progress of various aspects of the Road Safety Program. As the Strategy was recently approved, the full KPI dataset for 2023 is not yet available. Several indicators require the establishment of new data collection, analysis, and/or processes which are currently in development. These KPIs will be reported on the Road Safety Dashboard once available.

A snapshot of the KPIs for 2023 is shown below. Note indicators that are not yet available are shown as "N/A". For a complete table of available current and historic values, and further details about how some indicators are measured, refer to **Attachment 4 – Road Safety Key Performance Indicators**.



4. Road Safety projects: What are we doing

This section of the report outlines some of the significant road safety initiatives which were completed or ongoing in 2023, and upcoming within the 2024/25 fiscal year.

4.1 REVIEW OF THE 2018-2023 STRATEGIC ROAD SAFETY FRAMEWORK

With the conclusion of the 2018 Strategic Road Safety Framework, staff performed an assessment of road safety trends, and the strengths and shortcomings of the Road Safety Program over the past five years. The Review of the Strategic Road Safety Framework 2018-2023 report was presented to Transportation Standing Committee in November 2023. Outcomes from the review were used to shape the next iteration of HRM's Road Safety Strategy.

4.2 DEVELOPMENT OF THE ROAD SAFETY STRATEGY

The development of the Road Safety Strategy began in 2023, with final approval by Regional Council in July 2024. The Strategy officially adopts Vision Zero for the Road Safety Program, underpinned with the concepts of the Safe System Approach. The Strategy incorporates evidence-based decision making and equity and inclusion as key principles for the Road Safety Program. Five priority areas - intersections; safe speeds; vulnerable road users; safe schools; and data management - create focus for the types of projects the Road Safety Program will dedicate the most resources.



4.3 PRIORITY AREA - INTERSECTIONS

Other continued intersection improvements included protected and restricted turning movements, systematic installation of leading pedestrian intervals (LPI), and new accessible pedestrian signals (APS). The Road Safety Dashboard provides the most current number of intersections installed with LPI and APS.

2024/25 Actions:

□ the work plan for road safety improvements in 2024/25 identifies two intersection upgrades:

- new traffic signal installation:
 - □ St Margarets Bay Road & Timberlea Village Parkway
- existing traffic signal upgrade: □ Oxford Street & Jubilee Road
- and restricted turning movements.

in-service road safety reviews were performed on the 10 highest priority intersections identified in the 2023 Road Safety Annual Report. Reviews incorporated collision data and near-miss analyses,

a recommendation report outlining proposed action plans for the 10 priority high-collision intersections was approved by Regional Council in July 2024. This report also included four additional locations for consideration of protected turning movements. Staff will continue to refine project scopes and will begin design for the proposed improvements. Four intersections are currently proposed to receive upgrades in the 2025/26 draft capital plan with the remaining locations to be incorporated in subsequent annual capital plans.

4.4 PRIORITY AREA – SAFE SPEEDS

Traffic calming

52 traffic calming projects were completed in 2023, with 30 additional projects carried over into the 2024 construction year due to delays caused from severe weather events. Most projects installed vertical deflections such as speed tables. For more information about traffic calming and to view the interactive traffic calming map, visit the <u>Traffic Calming</u> page on our website.

2024/25 Actions:

□ 72 new traffic calming installations are planned for the 2024 construction season, in addition to the 30 carryover projects from 2023.

Neighbourhood speed limit reductions

speed limits were reduced to 40 km/h in 10 neighbourhoods in 2023. To learn more about the neighbourhood speed limit reduction program and to view the interactive map, visit the Neighbourhood Speed Limit Reduction page on our website.

2024/25 Actions:

- □ staff will submit applications to the province to reduce the speed limit to 40 km/h in 10 new neighbourhoods in 2024/25.
- □ the Road Safety group will continue to advocate for change in legislation which would permit HRM to post lower speed limits without requiring Provincial approval. Provincial approval is currently a requirement for the municipality to reduce speed limits below 50 km/h.

Corridor speed limit reductions

In addition to neighbourhood speed limit reductions, speed limit reviews resulted in reductions on 14 corridor segments.

Reduced from 60km/h to 50 km/h:

- Kinsac Road, between Beaver Bank Road & Silver Leaf Drive
- Lucasville Road, between Civic 315 & & Hammonds Plains Road
- Bedford Highway, between Southgate Drive & Tremont Drive
- Bedford Highway, between Sherbrooke Drive & Windsor Street Exchange

Reduced from 70km/h to 50 km/h:



Mineville Road, between Highway 7 & Dempster Crescent

Reduced from 70km/h to 60 km/h:

- Windgate Drive, between Beaver Bank Road & Windsor Junction Road
- St. Margarets Bay Road, between Civic 5507 & Mason Point Road
- Caldwell Road, between Hines Road & Civic 1500
- Timberlea Village Parkway, between Highway 103 & St Margarets Bay Road

Reduced from 80km/h to 70 km/h:

- Hines Road, between Raptor Way & Caldwell Road
- Caldwell Road, between Hines Road & DeSaid Lake
- Burnside Drive, between Highway 111 & Akerley Blvd
- St Margarets Bay Road, between Civic 5106 & Civic 4692
- Mineville Road, between Civic 1081 & Lawrencetown Road

Speed display signs

Speed display signs (SDS), or driver feedback signs, are installed on major collector and arterial roads where there is a speed limit transition, community entrance, or where there is evidence that drivers may be prone to speeding. The SDS program allocates two signs to be installed per district. To learn more about speed display signs in HRM, visit the Speed Display Signs page on our website.

2024/25 Actions:

□ staff will continue to monitor requests and note installation locations where speed display signs may be an appropriate countermeasure. As these signs are most effective when first installed in a new location, road safety staff occasionally move signs from one road to another to achieve

4.5 PRIORITY AREA – VULNERABLE ROAD USERS

New and upgraded crosswalks

Crosswalk projects from the 2023/24 Road Safety Improvements capital plan included:



34 new Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) at new and existing crosswalks. one new crosswalk with RA-5 pedestrian activated flashing lights.

2024/25 Actions:

- □ upgrade 20 existing crosswalks with RRFBs.
- \Box install five new crosswalks with RRFBs.
- □ install two new crosswalks with overhead RA-5 flashing lights.
- □ install one new pedestrian half-signal.
- Continue upgrading multi-lane crosswalks with durable markings for enhanced visibility and extended life cycle.

High visibility crosswalks at signalized intersections

A 2023 research project evaluated the use of high-visibility (zebra) crosswalks at signalized intersections, finding that near-miss events were decreased when higher visibility crosswalk markings were employed.



as a result of this research, the municipality has adopted high-visibility crosswalks as a new standard at signalized intersections. Implementation will be phased through repaying projects and the existing durable pavement marking program.

2024/25 Actions:

intersections will begin to be marked with high-visibility crosswalks. The phased implementation of high-visibility crosswalks will begin with all new construction of signalized intersections, integration with repaving projects, and through the existing durable marking program.

Review of collisions involving pedestrians and micromobility users

As an ongoing practice to monitor for risk factors and trends in pedestrian and micromobility collisions, staff performed a review of all reported pedestrian and micromobility collision data from 2023. Key points of this analysis are outlined in section 2.1 Collisions involving pedestrians and micromobility users, and a list of collisions reviewed can be found in Attachment 2 - 2023 collisions involving pedestrians, and Attachment 3 - 2023 Collisions involving micromobility users.

2024/25 Actions:

- tactical projects; and strategic plans, including the Integrated Mobility Plan.
- occurred in 2023 for deficiencies and potential safety upgrades.



□ infrastructure supporting safe walking and micromobility, such as sidewalk, multi-use pathways, and bike lanes, will continue to be expanded through street recapitalization projects; new streets;

□ Road Safety staff will assess intersections where multiple pedestrian or micromobility collisions

4.6 PRIORITY AREA – SAFE SCHOOLS

School zone traffic calming



under the municipality's traffic calming program, vertical deflections were installed in 16 school zones in 2023.

as there are several school zones ineligible for vertical deflections due to street classification or other street characteristics, a pilot was conducted to test measures such as special pavement markings, flashing beacons and speed display signs. Pilot measures were installed at six additional school zones in 2023, however, evidence collected by HRM showed no significant impact on driver behaviour. Additional countermeasure options are limited in these areas due to street classification and geometry, however staff will continue to investigate opportunities for safety improvements.

All vertical deflections within the school zone traffic calming program are projected to be completed by 2026. A summary of the pilot is provided in the Review of the Strategic Road Safety Framework 2018-2023 report.

2024/25 Actions:

□ traffic calming will be installed in 15 school zones. There are four outstanding school zones eligible for vertical deflections and are planned to be installed within the next two years pending integration projects.

Safe School Streets

In late 2023, Halifax Regional Council moved that staff initiate a <u>Safe School Streets pilot</u>. Safe School Streets is an initiative aimed at creating a safer and more vibrant environment for students and the school community by temporarily limiting motor vehicle access to a street block adjacent to a school during arrival and dismissal times. It prioritizes the well-being of students by repurposing the road closure area for activities such as walking, biking, playing and socializing.



staff developed the framework for a pilot, which included establishing timelines and drafting an application process. Staff also participated in a committee for an external stakeholder school streets project, which is intended to start in the Fall of 2024.

2024/25 Actions:

- □ staff will continue to provide guidance on the externally-led safe school streets project that is planned for implementation during fall 2024.
- □ the internal Safe School Streets pilot is not intended to begin until completion of the external project. This is to ensure lessons-learned can be incorporated into the pilot. Staff will finalize the internal pilot project plans in anticipation of opening the application process in winter 2024/25. Upon selection of the schools for the pilot, school community volunteers will organize and facilitate the school street temporary road closures in spring 2025 and/or fall 2025.

Active School Travel

In December 2023, Halifax Regional Council moved for staff to proceed with the development of a municipally led Active School Travel (AST) program. AST programs are strategic initiatives with the goal of facilitating and promoting student travel by active modes. The proposed AST program will be built upon the fundamental components of infrastructure and route planning; education, promotion and encouragement; and data collection and evaluation.

2024/25 Actions:

the AST program are expected to begin in 2025/26 pending budget approvals.



□ staff are exploring options and concepts in the development of the Active School Travel program and participating in meetings of the externally-led School Travel Planning Group. First steps to implement

4.7 PRIORITY AREA – DATA MANAGEMENT

Road Safety open data

In 2023, a new interactive Traffic Calming Assessment Map was released, providing a new way for residents to view traffic calming information for any municipal street. Ranking lists will continue to be posted online in an accessible format.

2024/25 Actions:

a new interactive public map was released to support the neighbourhood speed limit reduction program. The map provides information on streets that are installed, in review and ineligible for 40 km/h speed limit reductions.

□ staff continually work with IT to adjust and make improvements to available public data.

Updates to Road Safety dashboard

The Road Safety dashboard was initially created to support the original Strategic Road Safety Framework and to provide transparency with road safety progress.

2024/25 Actions:

updates to the dashboard are in progress to reflect the new key performance indicators and overall goal.

Data analysis improvements

a new collision analysis model was developed for the internal collision database. This new tool enables staff to more efficiently export details from collision reports, simplifying the process to conduct detailed collision analyses.

a video analytics software was procured to identify and analyze "near-miss" conflicts occurring at intersections of interest. This software was used as a supplementary analytical tool in some intersection safety reviews and project evaluations completed in early 2024.

Additional details from police collision files were added to the HRM collision database.

2024/25 Actions:


functions (SPF's) and high-injury networks to better prioritize road safety needs.

Collision data quality

The 2023 review of the Strategic Road Safety Framework identified the quality of collision data as an area for improvement in the Road Safety Program. Concerns identified with the quality of injury severity data in closed police reports are a barrier to tracking and reporting indicators from the Road Safety Strategy.

2024/25 Actions:

□ staff will continue to engage with Halifax Regional Municipality Data Services, Halifax Regional Police, and Halifax District RCMP to investigate and address collision data quality concerns related to injury severity.



□ staff are pursuing options to obtain a new collision data management platform, with more powerful analytical tools. These additional analysis tools would enable staff to work more efficiently, and implement new techniques for analysis and evaluation, including the creation of safety performance

4.8 ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement plays an essential role in supporting Vision Zero and the Road Safety Strategy in the municipality. In 2023, 50 per cent of fatal and injury collisions involved aggressive, distracted, and/ or impaired driving.

Halifax Regional Police and RCMP Halifax Regional Detachment, partners in policing, share responsibility for targeting high-risk behaviours that lead to serious collisions. Both organizations participate within the Road Safety Steering Committee, and work alongside Halifax Regional Municipality Road Safety Staff to share information.

Traffic enforcement reports for 2023 from both organizations are found in Attachment 5 - 2023 Traffic **Enforcement Statistics.**

Actions reported by Halifax Regional Police:

Halifax Regional Police focus enforcement on monthly traffic themes, which aid the Traffic Unit in the design of proactive enforcement activities, while the Public Relations & Communication Section aligns public messaging each month. Although each month has a specific theme, officers are expected to keep all safety concerns in mind throughout the year. Speeding and cell phone distraction are significant issues, which require regular enforcement.

Monthly enforcement themes target nine road safety areas:

| INTERSECTION SAFETY | HRP members target enforcement at intersections where the majority of infractions are related to sign violations such as turning restrictions. These signs are typically in place to improve pedestrian safety, prevent high-risk turns and prevent shortcutting on residential streets. |
|--------------------------------|---|
| DISTRACTED DRIVING | Members focus primarily on identifying and enforcing against distraction caused by cell phone use. |
| OCCUPANT RESTRAINT | Enforcement and checkpoints deal with seatbelts and child restraints. |
| SPEEDING/AGGRESSIVE DRIVING | Officers are directed to conduct daily speed enforcement, particularly during the targeted month. Speed enforcement projects are done periodically in high problem areas. |
| MOTORCYCLE SAFETY | Members ensure that motorcycle drivers are licensed to operate a motorcycle, wearing the required equipment and that the vehicle is licensed with a valid inspection sticker. Severe crashes involving motorcycles in recent years have involved some, or a number of these deficiencies. |
| CONSTRUCTION ZONE DRIVING | The traffic unit conducted several projects in construction zones, targeting speed above the posted temporary limit. While slower speeds in construction zones benefit the safety of all road users, the primary focus of this theme is on the safety of workers. |
| IMPAIRED DRIVING | Officer's hours of work include some night shifts, specifically to focus on impaired driving. Enforcement includes traffic unit check points; patrol; targeted enforcement around establishments selling alcohol; and responding to complaints about suspected impaired drivers. |
| BACK TO SCHOOL | In September, members conduct targeted enforcement near schools, focused on behaviour around school buses, crosswalks and intersections near schools and traffic regulations in and around school zones. |
| WINTER SAFETY | Check points are used to ensure that vehicles are prepared for winter driving, looking for bald tires, damaged wipers and other deficiencies that impact the safety of the occupants and other road users. Check points in recent years have identified vehicles with severely worn tires, cracked frames and non-functioning brakes. |

Actions reported by RCMP Halifax Regional Detachment:

RCMP Halifax Regional Detachment use the same monthly themes as Halifax Regional Police to address specific road safety related concerns and coordinate public messaging and enforcement campaigns.

As of April of 2024, RCMP Halifax Regional Detachment have created a dedicated five-person traffic unit. Traffic members are collectively prioritizing road safety by targeting impaired drivers and aggressive driving throughout HRM. Some of the initiatives that have been completed to date were saturation patrols on the Victoria Day long weekend, the IWK child seat program, Highway of Heroes Motorcycle ride and targeted enforcement during the Halifax County Exhibition.

Moving forward, RCMP Halifax Regional Detachment traffic members will continue to implement road safety focused initiatives, which include:

- general pedestrian safety in the school area.
- on roads and highways.
- safety and reduce the risk of injury to members of the public.

Additionally, RCMP Halifax Regional Detachment traffic continue to implement further initiatives throughout HRM to reduce speeding, impaired driving, distracted driving and aggressive driving.

4.9 EDUCATION & ENGAGEMENT

The education campaign for 2023/24 focused on highlighting the infrastructure investments in road safety. This information was shared through Public Service Announcements (PSAs) and municipal social media channels.

The Road Safety website continues to be updated with new features and information for residents. There were notable spikes in 2023/24 web traffic aligned with PSAs relating to speed limit reductions. Statistics show that the largest share of web page visitors access the traffic calming page for information on assessments and projects.

Corporate Communications are working on the development of a public perception of road safety survey, which will be the baseline for the perception of road safety performance indicators. Staff are currently in the process to procure a research firm to design and carry out the baseline survey in late 2024/25.

• establishing the "move over" initiative. This initiative is designed to educate drivers on their responsibility to slow down and move to the left lane when passing emergency vehicles. 
• targeted enforcement and education at dangerous intersections. RCMP HRD traffic members will be identifying the most dangerous intersections in the HRM and targeting these intersections through enforcement and education. Reducing driving infractions at intersections is expected to improve road

5. Conclusions

2023 was a transitional year for the road safety program - with the review of the previous five years under the Road Safety Framework and the development of the new Road Safety Strategy, with an updated vision, goal and approach. In addition to these strategic projects, staff continued with the operational work of delivering ongoing road safety infrastructure programs and performing in-service road safety reviews.

For 2024/25 and beyond, staff are focusing work on projects which will support the five priority areas of the new Road Safety Strategy – Intersections; Safe Speeds; Vulnerable Road Users; Safe Schools; and Data Management.

Continued and evolving participation from Halifax Regional Police, RCMP Halifax Regional Detachment and Municipal Corporate Communications is crucial for improved road safety in the HRM. Road safety staff will continue to engage with and rely on these partners, as well as many more stakeholders, to deliver a well-supported multi-disciplinary road safety program.

Section 1.1: Executive Summary

This report summarizes traffic enforcement efforts conducted by Halifax Regional Police (HRP) officers during 2021-2023 for the Halifax Regional Municipality (HRM) road safety steering committee. Please note that enforcement efforts may have been impacted due to public health lockdowns resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic. These statistics include traffic enforcement summary offence tickets (SOTs) and charges laid issued throughout HRM by HRP officers. Please see end of summary for a full list of statistics¹.

- There was an increase of 44% in SOTs issued for aggressive driving from 2022-2023 (+62).
 - The largest increases were from increases in issued SOTs for passing school buses exhibiting flashing red lights increasing 88% from 2022-23 (+35). Careless and Imprudent driving SOTs also saw an increase of 87% (+26).
- Distracted driving SOTs saw an increase from 2022-2023 of 94% (+454).
- Speeding SOTs saw a decrease of -60% from 2022 to 2023 (-1063)².
- Intersection-related SOTs saw an increase of 47% (+350) over the 2022 period
 - Largely these increases were from SOTs related to failing to obey sign prohibiting turns (+232%,+130) and failing to stop at a stop sign (+131%,+149).
- No significant changes for Impaired driving related investigations (+3%, +11) over the previous year³.

Description

This report includes statistics from the HRM Police Records Management System (Versadex and Summary Offence Tickets) and are for RCMP Halifax Regional Detachment jurisdiction only. The statistics are for General Occurrence files (using the Uniform Crime Reporting Codes UCR) and do not include Calls for service in the CAD where offences were deemed unfounded or no one was located, and an offence cannot be determined (i.e. call of an impaired driver and no driver or vehicle located).

The below summarizes RCMP efforts in road safety and highlights areas determined by Halifax Regional Municipality's (HRM) Strategic Road Safety Framework. This framework includes speeding, stunting/driving, aggressive driving, distracted driving, impaired driving, pedestrian related, bicycle related, and younger demographic.

Methodology

Except for the Impaired driving section, all emphasis areas outline the number of summary offence tickets issued by RCMP throughout HRM between 2021-2023. The impaired driving section outlines actual investigations into impaired driving that were deemed founded.

RCMP Halifax Regional Detachment Response

Halifax Regional Detachment continue to focus efforts on curbing traffic related offences within the jurisdiction. A comparison of 2022 to 2023 presents a consistent number of tickets issued for pedestrian related, bicycle related, and young demographic. Speeding, stunting, distracted driving, intersection related, and aggressive driving show a decreased number of tickets issued. Halifax Regional Detachment reported a total of 550 impaired driving investigations in 2023, remaining consistent from 2022.
