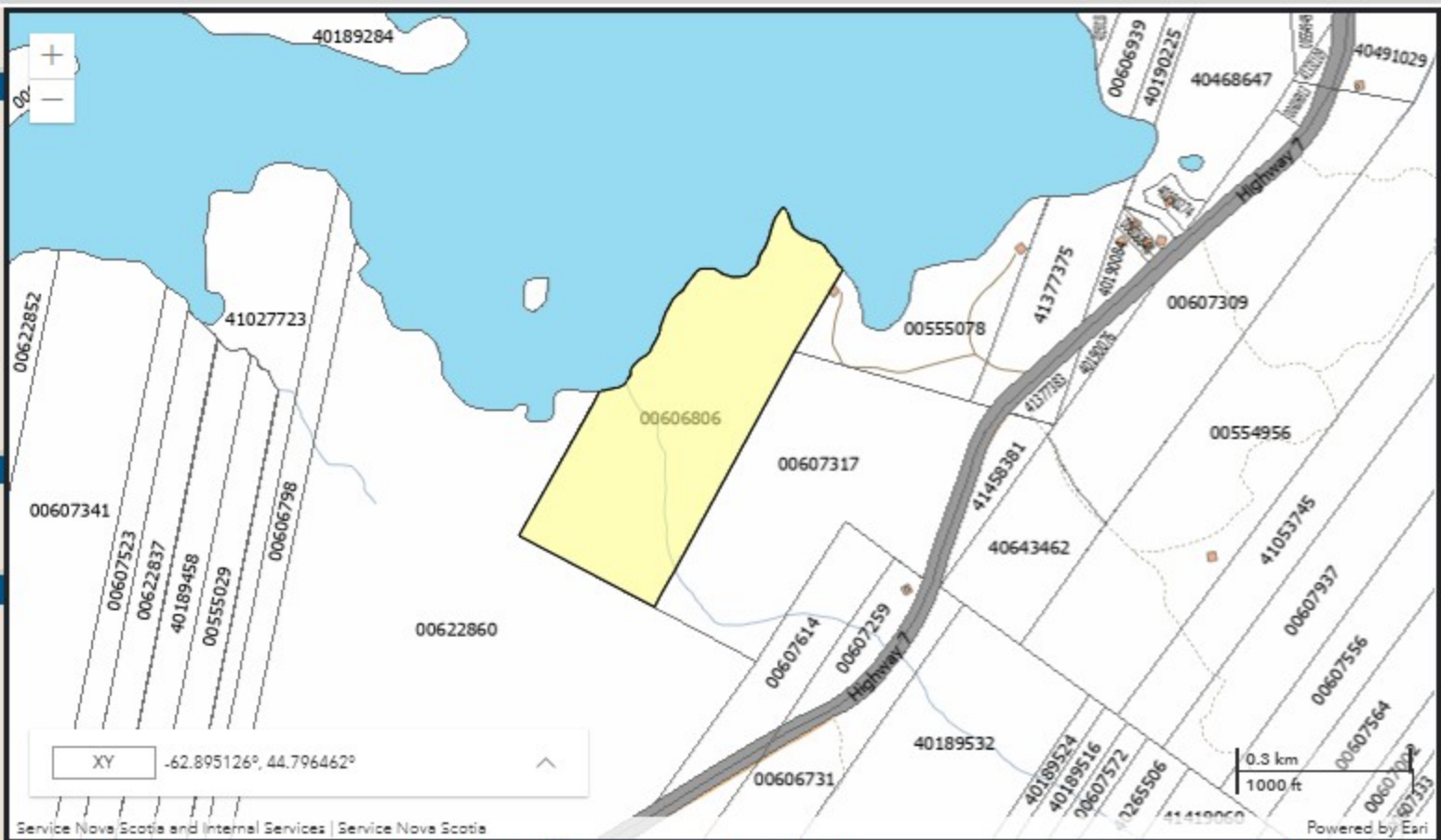

That part of the lands in Ship Harbour granted to Daniel Weeks in the Crown Grant recorded in Old Grant Book 14 at Page 61 dated September 16, 1784 and abutted as follows:

On the Northwest by the waters of Weeks Lake.

On the Northwest and Southwest by the 220 acres of land granted to William M. Dean, said grant recorded at the Halifax County Registry of Deeds in Grant Book 5 at Page 75 as Grant 14886 on March 5, 1885 (currently represented by PID 622860).

On the Southeast by the 42 acres of land granted to Charles E. Dean, said grant recorded at the Halifax County Registry of Deeds in Grant Book 7 at Page 192 as Grant 19492 on August 24, 1900 (currently represented by PID 607317) and the Lot identified as "Parcel D" as shown on the Plan signed on September 29, 1971 by E. J. Webber, Nova Scotia Land Surveyor, and recorded at the Halifax County Land Registration Office on in 1971 as Plan 10756 in Drawer 150 (currently represented by PID 555078).
