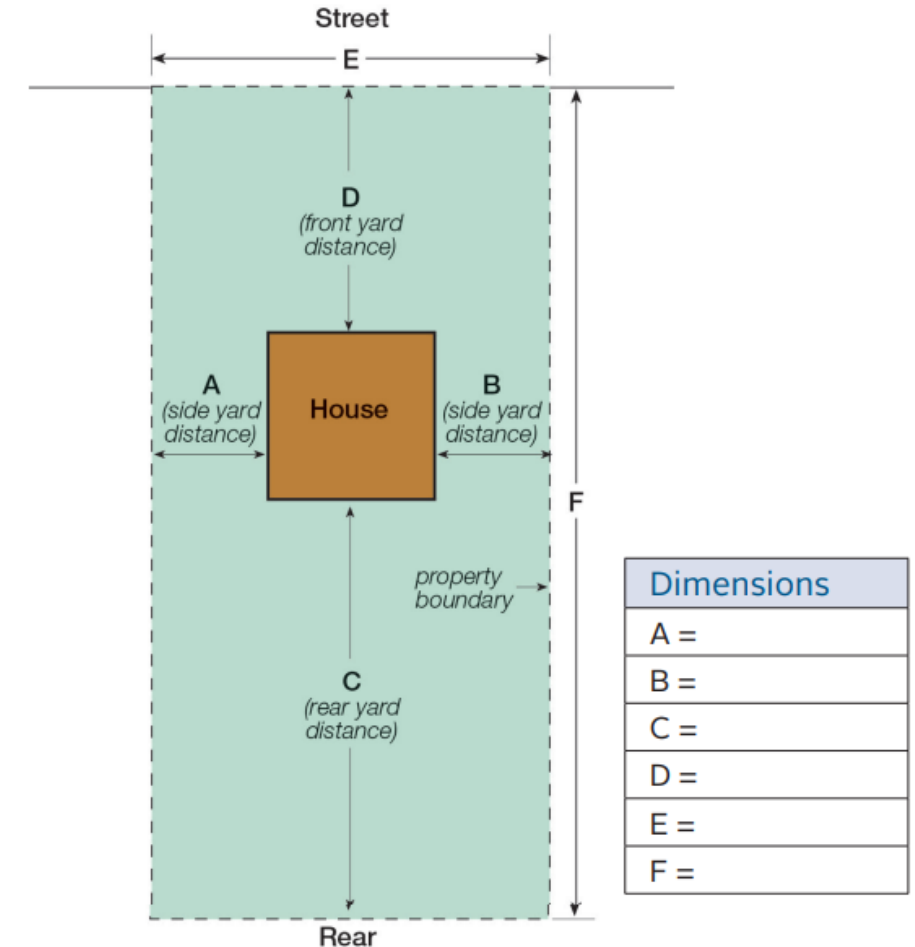
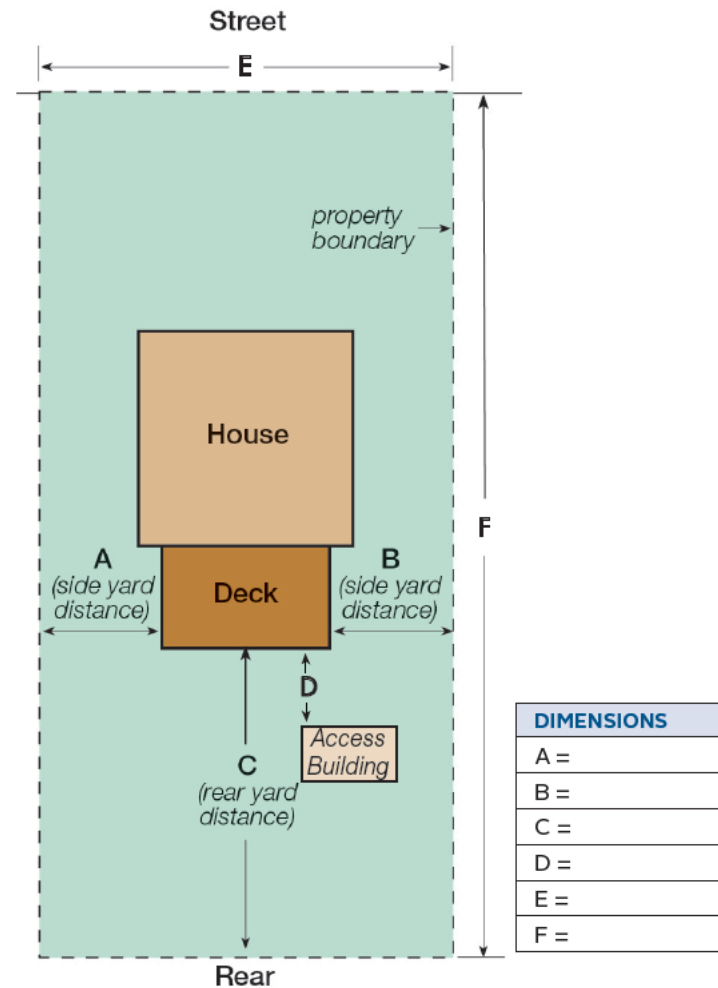


Site Plan – Example Diagrams

Site Plans

What to Include in a diagram:

- Must include lot dimensions and the footprint of the building, and any projections such as decks, roof overhangs and doorsteps.
- Indicate the proposed building's distance from all property boundaries, the location and dimensions of the driveway, existing buildings and setbacks to existing buildings.
- Indicate watercourses (such as lakes, streams or brooks).
- Include watercourse buffer and coastal area information (calculated in accordance with the applicable land use by law), when required.



Note: You may add as many dimension measurements as needed—there is no limit. (The example diagrams use A–F as a starting point).
