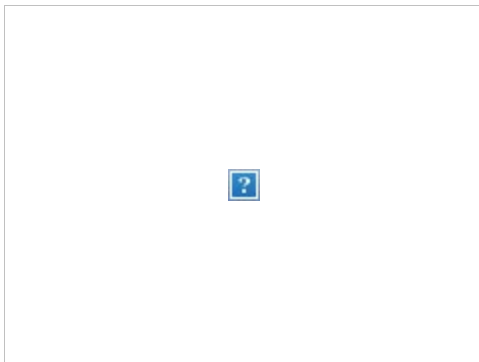
Dear HRM Clerks,
