### **Wanderers Block**



- Part of the Halifax Common
- Unique collection of tenants and public attractions
- Competing interests and spatial constraints
- More detailed planning needed



## **Proposals for Wanderers Grounds**

#### **Halifax Lancers:**

- Lease more space
- Second indoor riding arena
- More horses, stables and paddock space

### **Public Gardens Conservatory:**

- Victorian style botanical display house
- Year-round enjoyment of horticulture
- Visitor access & programming



## **Proposals for Wanderers Grounds**

#### **Wanderers Grounds Stadium:**

- Permanent grandstands, locker rooms, washrooms concessions
- Increase to 8,500 capacity with expansion to 10,000+
- Built and owned by HRM

### **Functional Plan**

- Collaborative planning process with all groups
- Spatial fit analysis of the current and proposed uses
- Maximum size of stadium
- Order of magnitude costing

### Out of scope:

- Financial and funding components
- Economic development assessments
- Alternative site locations







## **Key Findings**

- No one scenario meets all stated desires
- Advancing any proposal individually requires changes to other facilities
- Sewer pipeline bisecting site constrains where structures can go


- Wanderers Grounds site could support a soccer stadium of 8,600 fixed seats
- No space for stadium expansion unless other facilities are relocated
- Parking significantly reduced throughout site



- 8,000 seat stadium for soccer & rugby
- Second horse riding arena for Lancers
- No botanical conservatory



- 8,600 seat stadium for soccer only
- No second riding arena for Lancers
- Botanical Conservatory




- 7,100 seat stadium with north-south orientation
- Two new riding arenas for Lancers
- Larger conservatory connected to greenhouses
