THENCE North 47° 06.6' West a distance of 145.50 feet along lands of Harold P. Lemmon to a survey marker;

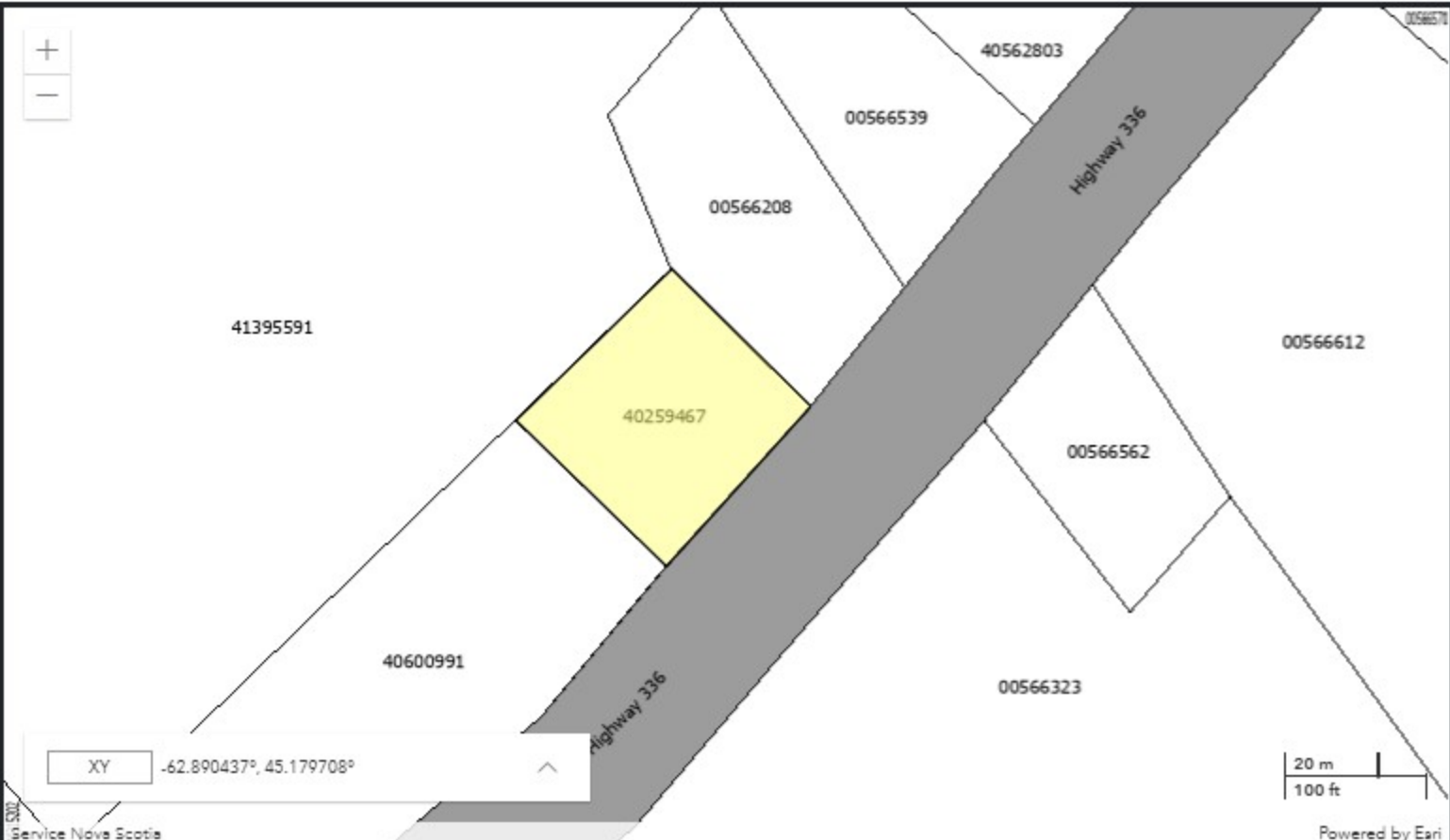
THENCE North 39° 15.3' East a distance of 150 feet along lands of Harold P. Lemmon to a survey marker;
