

**SCHEDULE "A"**

ALL that Piece or parcel of land, situate on the West side of Ecum Secum, Halifax County, Province of Nova Scotia, and on the East side of the Ecum Secum Highway;

Bounded and described as follows:

Starting at a stake by the clift north of house and on the Highway Boundary;

THENCE running 40 feet in a southerly direction to a stake,

THENCE running 40 feet in a easterly direction to a stake;

THENCE running 40 feet in a northerly direction to a stake,

THENCE running in a westerly direction to a place of beginning.

EXCEPTING A RIGHT OF WAY south of house, which John D. Pye stated in the Deed of the 12<sup>th</sup>. Of December, 1967, shall be retained by him and his heirs, or whoever may come into possession of the property adjoining Grantee.
