Thence South 25 degrees West 22 chains;

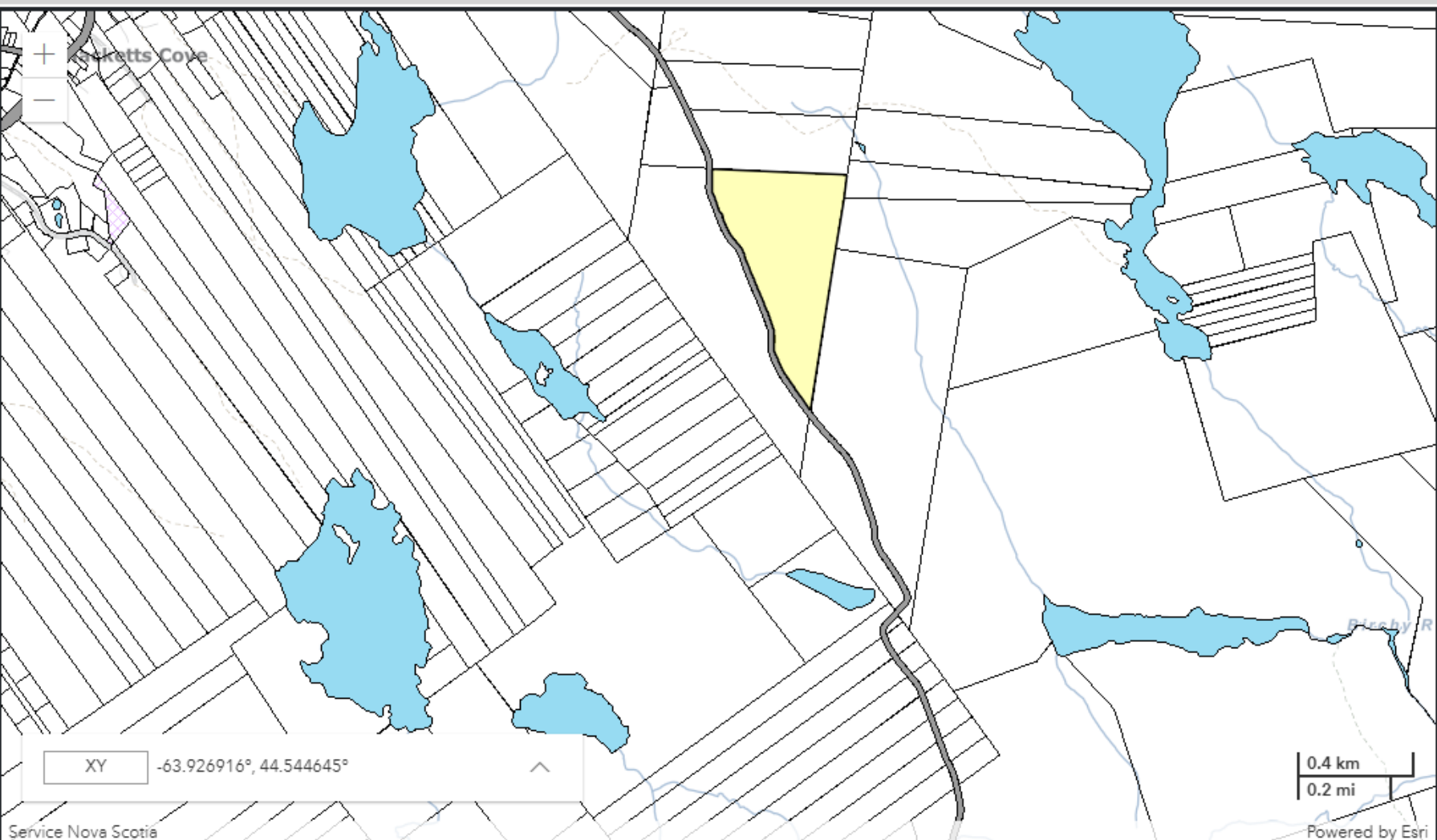
Thence South 80 degrees West 34 chains until it comes to lands granted to James Boutilier Senior;
